

# Valley Flyer to Metamora

Enjoy your time taking a trip through the beautiful Whitewater Valley from Connersville to Metamora. The Whitewater Valley Railroad is especially historic since it illustrates not one but two different eras of transportation. The railroad itself is built on the towpath of the earlier Whitewater Canal, and the old canal locks may still be seen along the right of way.

Arriving in Metamora you will find an authentic historic canal town. Watch corn stone ground in the old grist mill which dates to the early 1800's and the horse drawn canal boat can be ridden down the tree lined canal, over the only operating aqueduct in the United States to an authentic canal lock.

The center of Metamora is a blend of old businesses and homes holding antiques and specialty shops with gifts, antiques and collectibles.

Two hour layover in Metamora for shopping, eating and sightseeing. When the conductor calls, "All Aboard," it's time to head back into the present.

The Whitewater Valley Railroad is nestled in the heart of an area rich in history and scenic beauty. We eagerly await the opportunity to meet you and carry you to points of interest in the old style tradition.

#### Twilight Limited Train To Dinner

The Train to Dinner departs Grand Central Station at 6 pm on the first and third Friday, July through October, and travels to the Laurel Hotel for a delicious dinner. Choose from pan fried chicken, shrimp, catfish, cod or chopped steak that includes a tossed salad or coleslaw and a potato. Coffee or tea and then finish the meal with cobbler and ice cream. Prepaid reservations required. Round trip train ride, meal, tax and tip included.

First full weekend in October. Friday train departs at 10 am only for a two hour layover. Saturday and Sunday take our 10:00 am or 12:01 pm trains to Metamora. The train will leave Metamora at 3:30 pm. That means the 10:00 am train will have a four hour layover and the 12:01 pm train will have a two hour layover. Call for details.




