SMALL TOWN FOUNDED IN 1830's BY GERMAN SETTLERS.

A Small German Village with a brick street, signs in German and English and one of the Largest German festivals "Freudenfest". "A Walk-through Historic Oldenburg" will tell you about the marvelous German architectural influences. Enjoy even more German culture in one of the unique stores and family-owned restaurants while enjoying Sister Cleo's ice cream.



The painted hydrants started in 1976 during the Bicentennial. They started out painted as historic founders such as George Washington and Ben Franklin. Over time fading has taken place and are now being repainted to reflect important Oldenburg figures such as Father Franz Joseph Rudolf and Tinsmith Caspar Gaupel. But look close; I am sure there may be a few you might recognize.





From Indianapolis: Take I-74 East towards Cincinnati to IN-229, Exit 149, toward Oldenburg. Turn left onto IN-229. Travel about 2.6 miles to Oldenburg. Turn right on IN-229/Main St. Travel 0.1 miles and turn right onto Pearl St. Travel 0.1 miles to Oldenburg. Continue north on Pearl St. 0.1 miles. Turn right onto IN-229/Main St. Continue to follow IN-229 approximately 10 miles to US-52. Travel 0.6 miles to Metamora. Continue on US-52 for about 8.1. Turn right onto Main St./US-52/IN-1. Drive 0.3 miles to Brookville. To get to the Whitewater State Park/Brookville Lake continue to follow IN-1. Staystraight to go onto IN-101. Continue to follow US-101 for 9 miles.

Exploring THE WHITEWATER CANAL TRAIL

Visitors to Metamora have lots of options for enjoying the Canal Trail.


The grist mill and the covered bridge aqueduct are along the trail route in Metamora.

Traveling west from Metamora, it's about 4.5 miles to the Laurel Feeder Dam. This route takes you along the wooded Whitewater River Valley to the Laurel Feeder Dam.

To the east, the trail takes you through a scenic agricultural area and past the Twin Locks. At the Yellow Bank Area, you can see the new pollinator garden and Lock 21.

The blue squares on the map below show the distance on the trail from its starting point at the Feeder Dam.

Some of the trail's major features, and their location of the trail, are highlighted in the text following the map.



MILE O

Laurel Feeder Dam Just over the hill from the trailhead parking lot, you will find the Laurel Feeder Dam-a dam that "feeds" water

into the canal. Of the seven original feeder dams built for the Whitewater Canal, this is the only one still in existence. It keeps the water flowing in the canal for the grist mill in Metamora and then all the way to Yellow Bank Creek.

MILE 4.75

Metamora Grist Mill

The restored Metamora grist mill stands as a reminder of the many water-powered mills that operated along the canal until the early 1900s. These mills promoted agricultural and industrial development in the newly formed state of Indiana and continued to operate long after the railroad replaced canal boats for hauling freight.

MILE 5.15

Duck Creek Aqueduct

This aqueduct is basically a bridge that carries the canal across the creek. The Duck Creek Aqueduct is the only covered bridge aqueduct still standing in the United States. It is restored and maintained in its mid-19th century appearance. Take a minute or two to look at the curved timber trusses that support the aqueduct.

MILE 5.5

Millville Lock #24

A short distance down the trail you will pass Lock # 24: This restored structure lets us see how canal locks were used to raise or lower canal boats to follow the level of the surrounding countryside. Lock 24 was previously the site of a woolens mill, and the group of homes and buildings that developed around it was known as "Millville".

MILE 7.5

Twin Locks Area

Generally, locks are 1 to 3 miles apart on the Whitewater Canal. Because this is a steep section of the river valley, these two locks are only about 750 feet apart, so they are called the "Twin Locks". Near the sign kiosk, you will see a side trail takes you to Lock #23. As you walk, you will see the stone wall of the lock – and then get a view of the lock from water level. Lock 23 is deteriorating with age. Compared to Lock #24, it shows how much work is nvolved in restoring and maintaining a canal lock. For your safety, and to help preserve this historic structure, please do not climb or stand on the walls of the lock. After you return to the main trail you will pass RR milepost 49. In another 500 feet, you will reach



MILE 8.65

Goose Creek Aqueduct

After the railroad took over the transportation of freight and passengers along this corridor, there was no longer a need for large aqueducts like the one in Metamora. This small aqueduct, which you can see from the trail bridge crossing Goose Creek, is typical of the structures that carried the canal's water to supply power for the mills downstream.

MILE 10.5

Yellow Bank Area

As you approach the Yellow Bank Trailhead, you'll see the new pollinator garden that's planted with a variety of native plants. Designed in the shape of the WCT logo, this 2022 addition to the trail offers a place to take a quiet stroll for a few minutes. Just across the bridge over Yellow Bank Creek is a side trail to Lock 21. This lock is dry so you can walk into the lock chamber or stand on the platform at the edge of the wall and get a feel how much work it took to build the canal in the 1830s, without the aid of any machinery. In the low-lying area past the parking lot is a wildlife habitat area. The nest boxes that you see along the parking area and the trail provide homes for bluebirds, tree swallow and other cavity-nesting birds.

Exploring HISTORICAL PLACES

Franklin county is filled with many little communities. The local water routes are what started many people's adventures to the area.

Brookville is nestled between the two forks of the Whitewater river, the East and the West, just before they join. This location, with hills rimming the town, has provided both natural beauty, and risk of flooding since its early days.

Settlers were living in the area that is now Metamora as early a 1811, when the land became available for purchase. Prior to the twelve mile purchase of 1809, this land was still reserved for the Native Americans, though traders and frontier families where already locating outside of official boundaries in the fertile river valley.

From Germany, large numbers of immigrants landed in Cincinnati as the point from which they spread throughout Ohio and Indiana. Some of these immigrants settled near the clearings of William George and the others. And to these Germans, the area became fondly known as Neu Oldenburg.

Laurel is a lovely area along the West fork of the Whitewater river which was first occupied by white settlers when Benjamin Maple built his log cabin there in 1811.

With Franklin County being created in 1811 we are known for our history. As you explore our county here are just a few of the places you will be able to visit.







Aqueduct

SEE THE NATIONS'S ONLY KNOWN WOODEN AQUEDUCT

Originally constructed in 1843, The Duck Creek Aqueduct is very unique. So much so that it was featured in an edition of Ripley's Believe It or Not. It is the only known covered wooden aqueduct still operating in the United States. (indianamuseum.org)

Barrickman Cabin

2

Cabin located at Brookville Town Park. Most of the history has been lost on this cabin but according to a local historian, Virgil Davis it stood on Templeton's Creek and was moved here to commemorate Amos Butler's 1805 settlement of Brookville that occurred near this site. (Tour of Historic Brookville, Indiana)

Laurel Jail

3

This Laurel Jail, located on Commerce Street behind the business buildings, was built circa 1891 – of limestone quarried from the community. It was rebuilt after the original was destroyed in a fire that ravaged part of the town. This building served as a jail for the town of Laurel for many years.





Laurel Bandstand

The Laurel Bandstand is built on what is reported to be an Indian Mound – the highest point in Laurel. It appears that a bandstand was originally built on this site in 1892. This bandstand and the area around it was used for many years as a "pleasure resort" or more appropriately a town park.

Spires in Oldenburg

5

The most distinctive architectural aspect of Oldenburg is its many spires and that 80 of the roughly 115 homes in the historic district were constructed prior to 1900. Also look at the signs, they are in German and English. (A Walk-through Historic Oldenburg)



Brookville Library

6

We are fortunate to still have an original Carnegie library which has played a role in the community since 1912. The library houses an exceptional collection of artworks from renown historic artists such as J. Ottis Adams, Otto Stark, and T.C. Steele, as well as contemporary artists, such as Dale Benedict.







LOCKS

Several Locks can be seen throughout the county. Originally, there were 23 Locks and three Feeder Dams in Franklin County. Today, 14 Locks and one Feeder Dam still exists. Some are on private property.

Brookville Church and Cemetary

8

This Church was originally built in 1821 and is now located in the Brookville Cemetery that holds notables that include a state supreme court justice and one of the signatories of Indiana's first constitution

Old Church

Little Cedar Grove Baptist Church was organized in 1797 by some of the early Primitive Baptist settlers of Franklin County, Indiana. The historic church building, constructed in 1812, is the oldest church in the state of Indiana still standing on its original foundation.


